Bus facility will be provided to day scholars on payment basis . The Institute will also provide Bus facility to transport the students for practical training in different hospitals of the area.



Mode of Admission

Application must be made on the prescribed form available in the prospectus only. Application complete in all respects must be sent under Registered A.D. cover addressed to Principal Rehbar Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhawanigarh or in person at the counter during office working hours along with following documents



- 1. Attested copies of Educational Qualifications certificates.
- Attested copies of testimonials from the head of the institutions last attended.
- Ten recent passport size photographs(One photograph duly pasted on the Application Form).
- An undertaking from Parents/Guardian ensuring to meet all financial obligations of the candidate during her training period.
- Scheduled Caste/Scheduled tribal Certifacte from Tehsildar or Sub Divisional Magistrate if applicable.
- 6. A certificate of equivalency, if required.
- List of visitors with their photographs and speciman signatures, who may be allowed to visit the candidate during her stay in Hostel/Training Period.
- Medical fitness will be pre-conditions to the courses of the Institute. Selected candidates are medically examined by the Institute Doctors.



Eligibility for GNM

Age: the candidate shall be 17yrs, to 35yrs, upto 30 sept, of the academic year.

Educational Qualifications : Minimum Qualification shall be 10 + 2 or its equivalent, minimum 40% marks.

Residence Certificate/Income Certificate are necessary

Medical: Candidate should be medically fit.

Preference: Preference shall be given to those who have passed 10+2 or its equivalent with science subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry & Biology.

Admissions for GNM & ANM

The following conditions would apply to admissions in GNM & ANM Course.

- (a) The admissions should be purely on merit of 10+2 marks for GNM and ANM Courses.
- (b) Preference shall be given to those who have passed 10+2 or its equivalent with science subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry & Biology for GNM Course.
- The admissions would be finalized by 31st August and the classes (c) would commence from 1st September duration of course
- (d) If at any stage, it is found that the candidate has supplied any false information in the admission form, then her candidature for the course shall be cancelled.



The Duration of the course for General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) is for a period of 31/2 years and ANM Auxiliary Nurse and Midwifery (ANM) is for a period of 2 years. And after this diploma courses, students get themselves registered with State Nurses Registration Council as per their normal procedure of conducting the examination.

Method of Selection:

Eligible candidates will be called for interview before a board constituted by the management committee of the Institute.

Eligibility for Final Examination:

To be eligible for admission to annual examination, the students should have:

- (a) Attended not less than 75% of the total classes for each paper (Lectures, Practicals and Field Work)
- Completed the practical training requirements. (b)
- Records of practical experience, duly completed and signed by (c) the principal.
- (d) Pursued a regular course of studies for a minimum period of 11 months in a year.
- (e) Met the field experience requirements

Supplementary Examination:

The supplementary Examination will commence in March every (a)











- (b) If a student fails in two or more papers or practical she shall not be promoted to the next year. She can sit for supplementary examination in the failed subjects/practicals only. If she does not clear the supplementary, she can appear in the next main examination. She shall be promoted to the next year of study only after clearing the papers either in supplementary or in the main examination. She shall be eligible for the examination of the next year after one academic of the passing the last examination(main).
- (c) If a student fails in one Theory Paper/Practical examination of third year, she will be allowed to sit for supplementary examination held subsequently in the failed subject/practical.

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Scheme for Examination as per PNRC:

All the students are to take the following examinations:

- PTS Examination: This is an internal Examination conducted by the Institute after three months of admission. Only those candidates who qualify this examination with 50% marks will be allowed to continue the training.
- 2. Internal Assessment: This is based on the performance of the students in the class room, practical work in the wards/community field etc.
- 3. First State Nursing Examination: After the completion of first year of training students will have to pass the House Selection Examination (which will be conducted by the Institute). Candidates who fail in this House Examination will not be allowed to take up the test for the first year. Such failure candidates will be put back by six months in their training.
- 4. Second State Nursing Examination: After the completion of second year of training students will again be put to the House Selection Examination (which will be conducted by the Institute). Successful Candidates will be able to take the test for Second year and on successfully clearing this examination, they will be eligible for their training in third year.
- Third State Nursing Examination: Similarly, after completion of 3rd year of training and qualifying the House Selection Examination, students will be allowed to take the test for third year.

All students as well as those students who fail in any examination are required to complete minimum of 75% of the lectures before taking up the nest examination.

FEE STRUCTURE: Fee structure as per Government norms

Fee structure is subject to approval by the Government of Punjab. This may be revised.

- 1. Students will have to pay for the uniform & books separately.
- Students selected shall be required to deposit their fee on the same day, after declaration of the selection list, otherwise the seat will be given to the next candidate on waiting list.



- 3. Tuition Fee, Boarding & Lodging fee are to be paid till 7th of every month.
- 4. Late fee of Rs. 25/- per day will be charged after 7th day of every month.
- 5. If fee is not paid with in a month the name of the student will be struck off the roles automatically & readmission fee of Rs. 2000/- shall be in addition to the late fee and student will be readmitted.
- 6. Fee payable in advance & other charges once paid are not refundable in full or part or any claim for refundable in full or part on any account whatsoever.
- 7. If a student fails to take the examination for any reason, the institute will not entertain any claim for refund of the fee.

Fees mentioned above is provisional. Fee can be changed according to by the Fee Fixation Committee.



Examination Fee & Other Expenses:

Students will be responsible for submitting their examination fee, registration fee, travelling expenses and accommodation during their examination at the level of State Council.

Vacations:

Annual Leave: 30 days - Absence or any other kind of leave taken other than medical leave will be deducted from annual leave.

Medical Leave: 10 days only on recommendation of Medical Officer.

Preparatory Leave: 7 days prior to examination.

DIPLOMA:

On completion of training and passing all prescribed examinations, students will recieve a diploma in " General Nursing & Midwifery " from the Punjab Nurses Registrarion Council. There after they will have to register themselves with the PNRC and obtain a Registration Certificate for practice.

Dress Code:

The following uniform is compulsory for the students during their training course:

- a) On Duty: Pink suits along white aprons, length prescribed is one inch below the knees.
- b) Black shoes with white socks. No jewellary is allowed with uniform and hair should be properly tied up.
- c) Off Duty: Students must change over to their casual wear.
- d) Winter Scheme: Black Jersy with V-neck. Black mufflers & gloves are permitted off the classes & duty.

NURSING TRAINING & DUTY:

General & Disciplinary Norms of the Institute:

- 1. The Director Chairman of the college shall have the right to reject the candidture of any student seeking admission without any reason.
- 2. The Director Principle will have the right to cancel admission of any.
- 3. Student on disciplinary grounds during the Course at any time.
- Attendance of minimum 75% of delivered lectures in each paper will constitute the basic eligibility for each final examination.
- 5. Fees once deposited shall not be refunded.
- Fee must be deposited at time otherwise the candidate has to pay the late charges.
- For gross indiscipline, a student can be eliminated from the Institute in that event, no refund of any type of deposits will be made.
- Any student who wants to leave the Institute before the completion of course, has to pay the fee charges of the complete course.



Students must abide by the rules and regulations of the Institute and any disobedience or taking part in the strike or any kind of activity to create any disturbance in the Institute discipline will be seriously looked into. The Institute will not be responsible for any loss/damage from what so ever cause, arising to any properly belongings to the students living in the hostel. They are advised to leave all the valuable and jewellary etc in their homes. Students shall be responsible for any loss/breakage of the Institute equipment caused through the negligence, and they shall be charged accordingly to mitigate the same. The amount may be added to their fee installments etc.

Mobile Phone are not allowed in classroom & hostel.

Migration:

Migration from RIMS to anu other Institute/School for the same programme is not

permitted without the prior approval of the concerned Principal of both the Institutes. If any student wants to discontinue her studies due to any reasons, she shall have to deposit the full amount of admission fee as well as Tution fee for the entire course.

Legal Assistance & Jurisdiction

All disputes will be subjected to the jurisdiction of the courts at Sangrur only.







HOSTEL FACILITY:

Hostel facility is available to all deserving students. The hostel accommodation is on twin/triple sharing basis and speak of comfort, hygiene, quality & safety, Hostel accommodates a dining hall, recreation room and other necessary facilities.

Hostel Norms:

The student has to abide by the rules and regulations prescribed by the authorities from time to time.

It is compulsory for the students residing in hostel to eat in the hostel mess. Payment for the food is on monthly basis. Charges are liable to change with prior notice of one month.


- a) Student should co-operate in the upkeep of hostel and its good name.
- b) Rooms should be kept clean and tidy. Students are fully responsible for furniture supplied to them.
- Cup Boards/Boxes should be properly locked. Jewellary and Expensive items are not permitted in the rooms.
- d) Allotment of rooms is made by the Warden but change can be made on request.
- e) Water in Hostel is available for 24 hrs but wastage and carelessness will render the students disciplinary action.
- f) Relatives are not permitted in the rooms.
- g) Parents/Relatives should visit the students during visiting hours from 10-00 a . m . t o 12-00 Noon and 3-00 p.m. to 5-00 p.m. in warden's office on Sunday.
- h) If parents wish that their wards can travel alone they should give their consent in writing to Principal. The departure & arrival time must be entered in the register maintained by the college.
- i) Training can be discontinued in case of misconduct.
- j) Food will be provided in the dining hall only.
- k) Towels/buckets shall not be left in the bathrooms and cloth/cotten/refuse etc. is to be thrown in the dustbins. Misuse of Bathrooms will be severely punishable.
- Heaters/Stoves/Electric irons are not allowed to be used in the rooms, which may invite penalty of at least Rs. 500/-.
- m) Students must sleep in their own resp. beds and in their own rooms only.
- Take care not to leave water taps or lights on, when not needed. Economy is use will be appreciated.
- Night duty students are not allowed to go out before 4-00 p.m. except with prior permission, before /after a night duty off.
- p) Except for going on duty, prior permission to leave the hostel will have to be taken by the student before leaving the hostel, that even for specified time only. On return form leave taken, return of the student to hostel shall have to be notified by the student to the hostel warden.
- r) Hostel Warden/Principal or Person nominated to do so by the Managing Director of Institute can check the hostel room anytime.
- s) students are required to follow the rules & regulations of the Hostel/Institute from time to time and must maintain discipline and decency during the training period.
- t) Students are not allowed to meet any visitor, not mentioned in the list of visitors permitted by her parents/guardians which is submitted at the time of admission.
- u) Visitors/Relatives of the students are not allowed to stay in the hostel during night hrs. In case of lady visitor, special prior permission for stay shall have to be taken from the Hostel Warden/Principal/Managing Director.
